**DATE / TIME: Sunday; March 11, 2018; 4:30 pm. REPORT TIME: NLT 3:30 p.m. (Kalakaua Ave. will be closed to all traffic at around 3:50 p.m.)**

**ASSEMBLY AREA:** Assemble at Ft. DeRussy Park fronting Kalakaua and Saratoga (Vicinity Mauka of the Post Office on Saratoga Rd.; around Center of Park facing Kalakaua Ave.)(Look for the Lions Banner)

**ROUTE:** From Kalakaua/Saratoga through Waikiki on Kalakaua to Kapiolani Park in front of the zoo. (About 1.5 miles). A trolley will be available for those who have difficulty walking the 1.5 miles.

**PARKING:** Parking available at Kapiolani Park vicinity the Shell on Monsarat. (Lot closest to Paki St.) Catch the shuttle bus to the assembly area to starting point.

**UNIFORM/EQUIPMENT:** Lions vest or club uniform. Bring your club banner. Wear comfortable shoes. Bottle water will be provided.

About 3,000 visitors from Japan and the Pacific Basin nations are expected to participate in the Honolulu Festival March 9 – 11, 2018 throughout Waikiki and the Convention Center, concluding with the gala parade on Sunday. A fantastic fireworks display by Nagaoka Ciy, Japan will take place off Waikiki after the parade at around 8:30 p.m.
