



**Vision Screening  
Critical Line Quickie Guidelines**

- CRITICAL LINE SCREENING is the method of screening to be used for those without S12s.
- ONLY ONE LINE OF OPTOTYPES (SYMBOLS OR LETTERS) IS DONE, BASED ON AGE  
They are called Visual Acuity Thresholds.
- Pass is 3/5 per eye.
- The recommended grade levels for chart screenings are P (3&4), K, 1, 3, and 5.
- P or Pre does not include 24 mos.
- Unless you are presently screening a middle/intermediate school, we are not adding this level.
- All off grade levels screened are with agreement between the club and the school.
- Acuity tests are recorded one eye at a time.
- There is no 'retest' or 'second chance' with critical line screening.
