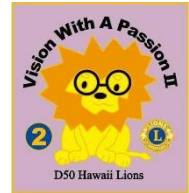




The District 50 Vision Screening Incentive Pin Program Pins One (1) and Two (2)



In order to encourage greater participation in D50 coordinated vision screenings using the D50 protocols and to recognize those who give of their time and effort to help make vision screening of all children a reality, a set of merit pins has been organized to recognize these Lions. Vision pin points for pin #1 will be calculated beginning July 1, 2011. Pins will be awarded until the quantity of pins has been exhausted or I get another donation to continue them.

There are separate goals for each of the pins. The first pin is to encourage Lions to participate in a D50 Lions sponsored Vision Screening, regardless of who the sponsoring D50 Lion's club is.

The second pin is to encourage Lions to participate in D50 Lions sponsored Vision Screenings outside their own club, or zone.

Pin Requirements

Pin #1.

Points accrued need to total 20. A certificate of achievement and a white vision pin #1 will be presented to the recipient. The type of points accrued does not matter, only the total. See the matrix below for the points schedule.

Pin #2.

1. A Vision Screening Pin #1.
 2. A minimum of 50 points (30 beyond pin #1) BEFORE points are accrued and aggregated for pin #2.
 3. It is irrelevant which type of screening is done – S12, Spot, or Critical Line.
 4. Tally for the points needed to start working on pin #2 will be calculated starting with points earned AFTER July 1, 2016.
 5. The number of screenings done outside of the club must equal 20 or 40 points.
 6. The number of screenings done in one's own zone are limitless.
- Pin points are derived from the attendance rosters maintained by the screening's Vision Coordinator. The attendance roster is forwarded to Lion Phil Sharp Sharps-solutions@hawaii.rr.com or handed directly to him on the day of the screening to be entered into a database created for this purpose. A participation report of the attendance of a screening is returned by him to the coordinator and as many of the individual participants as possible for verification. Once this has been done, no changes to the roster are permitted. If a coordinator does not turn in a roster, no points are given.
 - All determinations concerning the Vision Screening Incentive Pins are the responsibility of Lion Phil Sharp. No other Lions are part of the input.
 - Monies to finance the program has come from direct donations by individuals or other sources. No Lions monies are used to finance this program.

The only way that Lions will be recognized and credited with points for a pin is through the check in roster that everyone should sign when they come to a screening. Therefore, all Lions must PRINT their first and last names legibly and list their club affiliation. The Lion in charge of the screening needs to send Lion Phil Sharp a copy of this roster to: Sharps-solutions@hawaii.rr.com.

The only recognized screenings, for the purpose of earning a vision pin, are those sponsored and coordinated by a Lion's club. **NO POINTS ARE GIVEN FOR PARTICIPATION IN A SCREENING SPONSORED OR COORDINATED BY ANOTHER ORGANIZATION REGARDLESS OF THE FACT THAT LIONS ARE PARTICIPATING.** Neighbor island clubs please contact Lion Phil, 373-3998 or his email listing sharps-solutions@hawaii.rr.com.

The following matrix shows the type of participation and the point values that can be earned for pin #1. The screening report given back to the coordinators shows the points earned by each Lion during the screening.

Code	Explanation	Points
RZ-P	Participant's Region and Zone	
RZ	Screening Club's Region and Zone (Based on coordinators region and zone.)	
P-Z	Participated in own Zone Screening	1
P-Z +	Participated in own Region Screening	2
P-R +	Participated in outside Region Screening	3
O-ZC -	Organize and participate in screening w/less than 50 students	3
O-ZC +	Organize and participate in a screening w/more than 50 students	4
New School	School that has not been screened for over 2 years	1

There are only two types of points given for pin #2.

Ones for screenings done in your zone and ones for screenings done outside your zone.

Points for pin #2 automatically began accruing on July 1, 2016.

No points are given for pin #1 after Pin #2 has started.

P-Z	Participated in own Zone Screening	1
P-Z +	Participated in outside Zone Screening	2
