**BIG CHANGE THIS YEAR!!!** Along with being the granddaddy fundraiser, this year the cafeteria will not be accessible. However, the Hawaii Kai Lions took on this challenge and leveled-up their game. The high school parking lot will be transformed into **Hawaii's Largest Drive-through Breakfast Takeout!** Such a logistical endeavor cannot be matched by any commercial fast food restaurant. On average, there are 6-12 cars at those drive-thru locations, the Lions will be cranking this up by **5 times!** This huge undertaking took quite some time in planning. On Father's Day, it is estimated that 1000 cars will come through and pickup their bento breakfast.

**The Hawaii Kai Lions Club** will serve over **3,000 BREAKFASTS** this Fathers' Day to raise money to fund community projects such as the annual Hawaii Kai Holiday Parade; vision and hearing screening for preschool and elementary school children; projects and monetary support for Hawaii Kai public schools; monetary support of Hawaii Kai Library, Kaiser High School Project Graduation, Junior Police Officer (JPO) appreciation events; and many other projects that make a difference in the community.

Tickets were presold and **all tickets have sold out.** The meal includes fried rice, link sausages, and scrambled eggs. Due to COVID restrictions, this year's event will be drive-through, pick-up only.

The Hawaii Kai Lions Club is a dedicated group of men and women that identify a number of critical community needs, then work together to raise the funds & manpower to fulfill those needs. More recently, Hawaii Kai Lions introduced **RESCUE TUBES;** personal flotation devices designed to assist distressed swimmers until lifeguards arrive. Over a dozen lives have already been saved in Hawaii Kai alone.

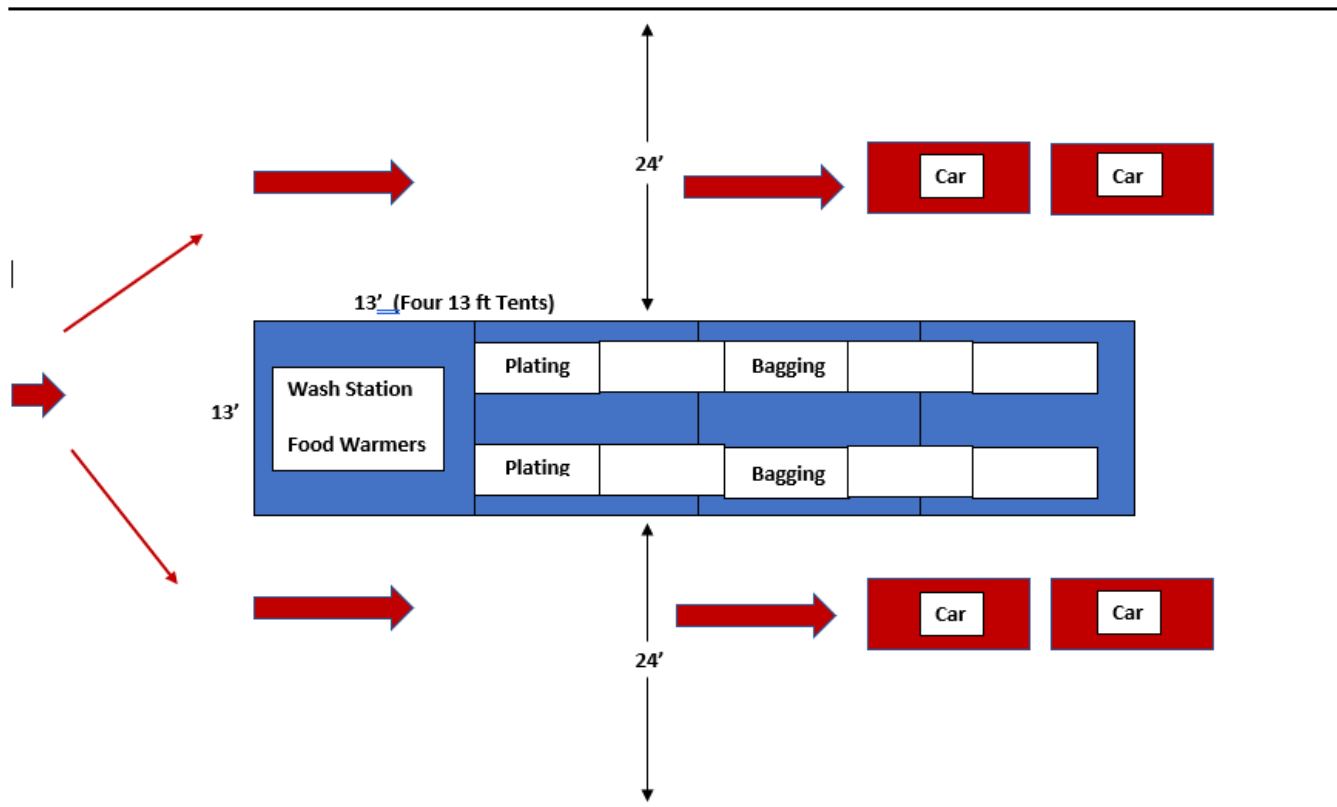
