



- Lions Kids Sight USA offers FREE Certification for vision screeners - online as individuals, or online in virtual groups led by a Certified Lion trainer.  - Your registration will be completed when you complete the test. Be sure to follow these steps when you are ready to take the test. (the website may timeout if you are not ready to take the test) This test shouldn't take more than 20 minutes. Be sure to know your LCI Membership ID#. It is recommended that you use a computer (instead of a Mobile Device or iPad or SmartPhone). A touch screen may make it difficult to navigate.
 - When ready to take the test, visit the website at: <http://e-district.org/sites/kidsightusa/page-11.php>
 - Review these quick instructions. All D50 Lions will be using the same Username and Password below.
 - Log into the Members Section at the left:
 - Username: **hi50**
 - Password: **KidUSA**
 - Then proceed to the Test.
 - The first section asks for your **email address, name, District, State** and **Membership ID#** - See your club Secretary for your Member ID.
 - The second section will be the 50 questions.
 - This is an Open Book test
 - When you have completed the test, you will get an email from Google Forms acknowledging your entry. But this is not the results.
 - At some time later, you will be provided with the "Results - Score" and if you passed, you will be provided with a PDF file of the Certificate showing that you have passed successfully. * **If you don't hear from anyone in a couple of days, email dan@uitti.net**; he will look for your results.
 - Included at the bottom of the Certificate is an indication where the Certificate can be validated by another agency (this could be DOE or DOH) with your permission.
