Hi Lions! Our Blood Bank donations are as follows: Lion Gerald Hirata – donated on June 24 at Dillingham Lion Vaughn Miyauchi – donated July 12 at Dillingham Lion Tom Fujita – donated July 25 Our team has saved 9 lives from June 24 – July 25.

This time, I decided to check how many pints our Pearl City Lions team has donated thus far. The results are as follows: Lion Clarence Nishihara (86 pints), Lion Brian Akimoto (66 pints), Lion Gerald Hirata (64 pints), Lion Tom Fujita (37 pints), Lion Charlenee Caraang (18 pints), Lion Diane Siperly (40 pints), Lion Brandon Elefante (10 pints), Lion Vaughn Miyauchi (85 pints), Sharon Ige (14 pints). The total of just this team is 420 pints.

At 3 lives per pint our team saved 1,260 lives.

There are past Lions and some Lions who are unable to donate now but have donated in the past, so our Pearl City Lions donation far exceeds this amount.
