**Number of persons benefiting**: Over 1000 people. **Description of Activity**: Control the flow of traffic in and out of Kaua'i Veteran Center throughout the day from 9am-3pm and hand out lucky-number tickets at the main gate. **Number of man-hours:** 52. **Final Expense to EKLC:** \$0.00. Kaua'i Veteran Center gave one \$10 food ticket, one \$3 beverage ticket to each volunteer.

In all cases, when the food order exceeded the price of the food ticket, the vendors accepted the food tickets, but no more cash. In at one case, the Lion opened the lid and found four beef ribs instead of three as specified by the menu. All of these cases exemplify a thought: Lions serve to serve others, not to be served themselves. However, such high regard bestowed on Lions reflects the honor that the community bestows on those who serve.
