District 50 is again sponsoring a local Lions Leadership Institute to help Lions build their personal leadership skills! A positive learning environment, Lion networking, idea sharing...what else could be better! This institute is for those who want to serve at the Zone and District level, or those who just wish to grow in Lionism. This year the Advanced Lions Leadership Institute will be held at the Lanakila Multi-Purpose Senior Center in Honolulu.

Participant Qualifications

1. Candidates are all District 50 Lions only, especially past and current Club Presidents and Officers, all in good standing with the Club and District. The total number of participants will be 25, with 8 from the neighbor islands (due to cost considerations).
2. Candidates must commit to pre-assignments, a two-and-a-half-day Institute schedule and all group mealtime activities. **Attendance in classroom sessions and scheduled activities is mandatory.**

Cost of the Institute

Each participant will pay a registration fee of \$125, payable to District 50 Hawaii Lions

What is Included

1. Certain study materials
2. Meals: Morning coffee and pastries and lunch daily; dinner on Saturday and Sunday
3. Neighbor Island candidates.
 - a. Round-trip airfare not to exceed \$200. Air reservations must be completed by December 31, 2022, with documentation provided to the Institute Coordinator for reimbursement.
 - b. Hotel accommodations will be on a shared room basis for Saturday and Sunday nights.
 - c. Ground transportation during the Institute.

Application Procedure and Deadlines

All candidates must complete the attached Application and Candidates History. The completed application form and registration fee must be postmarked no later than January 15, 2023. The application may be emailed, with the registration fee mailed separately. **There will be no cancellation refunds after February 1, 2023.** It is recommended that an email be sent ASAP to the Institute Coordinator, advising of the intended Candidate.
