HUMANITARIAN AWARD INFORMATION

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

The District 50 Hawaii Lions Humanitarian Award is bestowed by the District Governor to a person having demonstrated humanitarian accomplishment above and beyond personal, professional and civic duties.

ELIGIBILITY

The nominator:

- must be a Lions Club member or a Lions Club in good standing with LCI and District 50
- must complete and sign the nomination form.

The nominee must:

- be a non-Lion
- not have expected or received compensated for his/her service(s)

CRITERIA:

The Nominee:

- performed service(s) above and beyond one's personal professional and civic duties.
- has up to 2 letters of recommendations
- demonstrates significant contributions of benefits to the community (efforts include but are not limited to charitable work, philanthropy, education, and services to the disabled, underprivileged, senior citizens or youth)
- shows high community visibility highlighting the activity's cause or person, inspiring others in the community.
- implements activities that elevates awareness of social consciousness, promotes the dignity of life, and improves the quality of life for members of the community
- advances activities that exemplify mentorship in the community to promote growth and development in others
- demonstrates a high degree of personal involvement in other's need of support/assistance
- exhibits leadership skills (may include but not limited to organizing financial, physical, and human resources towards a positive humanitarian outcome)
- shows high degree of difficulty of achievement and sacrifices made
- shows evidence of potential to continue, promote, and expand their intervention
