From 1974 to 1994, Carole sponsored the Carole Kai bed race which raised \$2 million for the Variety School of Hawaii. The Variety School helped children and young adults with learning disabilities.

In 1985, she partnered with the late cardiologist, Dr. Jack Scaff, to co-found the "Great Aloha Run", which ran from the Aloha Tower to the Aloha Stadium. This year's race will be the 39th and final year that she will be the lead promoter and organizer of the event. Over the years, the Great Aloha Run has raised over 16 million dollars for over 150 non-profit organizations. Hawaii Lions Foundation is one of the non-profit organizations who benefitted from this event.
