Participant Qualifications

- 1. Candidates are limited to Lions who have been a **member for at least a year** and are in good standing with the Club and District. Due to cost considerations, the number of neighbor island Lions is limited to eight candidates.
- 2. Candidates must commit to pre assignments, the two and a half day Institute and group mealtime activities. **Attendance at all classroom sessions and scheduled activities is mandatory.**

Cost of the Institute

Each participant will pay a registration fee of \$125.

What is included

- 1. Meals: Coffee and pastries each day; lunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday.
- 2. Neighbor Island Candidates: (a Round trip air fare not to exceed \$200. Air reservations must be completed by November 20, 2023 or the candidate may be replaced by the next qualified alternate. b) Hotel accommodations on a shared room basis for Saturday and Sunday nights. c) Ground transportation during the institute.

Application Procedure and Deadline

All candidates must complete the attached Application and Candidates History. All completed documents and the registration fee of \$125 made payable to **District 50 Hawaii** must be postmarked no later than November 20, 2023. **There will be no refunds or cancellations after December 15, 2023.**
